- A banner is being made for our church on *Unbinding the Heart*. You will be seeing it later. Thank you Tammy Rismiller for making our "Countdown" board.


- There will be a prayer vigil on October 1, and you can sign up for this at a later time.

We are now past the midpoint of the summer season. There are undoubtedly questions regarding the nature and times of worship services come September. The Worship Committee along with the newly formed Contemporary Service Task Force and the Council are in the process of developing recommendations for the upcoming months of fall, however for at least September we will continue with one blended worship service at 9:30.



We are looking to offer some Sunday Adult Studies following the 9:30 service. On September 11th, coinciding with the date we bring in new members, Pastor Walt will lead a one session discussion entitled "So What Is a Lutheran Anyway?" This is not a study for new members only, but also for long time Lutherans who would like a refresher on what it is that those in the Lutheran tradition bring to the larger table of the universal Christian Church.

On September 18th and 25th there will be a two week study on the Book of Job entitled "Re-imagining the Book of Job" which examines recent studies which allow for radically new interpretations to the significance of a Bible story you thought you knew. Where is God in human suffering? Is God distant from the pain of people and the world, or is God personally inflicting the pain, or can this powerful book be suggesting conclusions which bring a new perspective challenging the idea of a distant Creator God?

Classes would begin following worship (about 11:00) and run for an hour. A meeting location has not been set, but most likely it would be upstairs in the Youth Room.
